## **Policy Statement**

We believe that children benefit most from early year's education and care when parents/carers and settings work together in partnership. ## Procedures

First Step Pre-school Ltd provide a website where information about the pre-school is accessible.

- We encourage and support parents to play an active part in the management of the Pre-school.
- We inform parents/carers about their children's progress through an on-line learning system called Tapestry.
- We welcome the contributions of parents.
- We inform all parents of how to raise queries, complaints or suggestions. All parents have access to our complaints procedure.
- At the induction meeting the parent is informed of all the different ways we communicate with each other:
  - o Newsletter termly
  - o Committee meetings
  - o AGM

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- Welcome pack (including relevant polices, parents are also informed where these can be viewed)

- o Notice boards
- o Members of staff are available daily to address any issues
- o Website / e-mail / phone / social media
- Communication with parents / carers is also promoted through the following:
  - An Annual General Meeting in the Autumn Term where we present our Annual Report which is made available to every parent through the website.
  - Any parent who would like a private meeting can do so by booking an appointment where discussions are confidential.
- Communication between staff is dealt with at regular staff meetings of which minutes are kept and circulated. Communication with staff and management is maintained by written and verbal information, termly assessments and yearly appraisals. Communication between the staff and Committee is done via Manager and Deputies.
